Description

Gateway Arch is a monument overlooking the Mississippi River, crossing through the 90-acre wide Gateway Arch National Park in St. Louis, USA. Finnish-American architect Eero Saarinen designed this 630-foot arch in 1947 and achieved its construction in 1965. The arch is emblematic of the city of St. Louis and symbolizes USA's westward expansion.
